The Jewish Way of Life Exhibition is designed to enable pupils, students and their teachers to gain a fresh insight into Judaism; a faith and lifestyle that has been sustained for over 5000 years by family values and a clear moral message. JWOLE is a travelling exhibition that has been on the road for over 30 years, but is constantly being improved and updated. The exhibition is suitable for Key Stages 1 to 3 and was written by educationalists to ensure that the teaching of Judaism fully supports all RE agreed syllabuses.

Visitors will experience Judaism through beautifully illustrated 6ft display panels with clear text, authentic artefact tables and hands-on educational activities.

We allow all artefacts to be touched and held because we believe this aids in the educational process.

This is a chance for your pupils to engage with Judaism in an original, exciting 'learning outside the classroom' experience.

The Jewish Way of Life exhibition will be open for schools from Tuesday 2nd March to Friday 19th March 2010. Each session can accommodate a maximum of sixty pupils and there will be three sessions a day:
